Located in Highland Perthshire, Blair Castle Woodland Lodges are situated in the historic grounds of Blair Castle, adjacent to the village of Blair Atholl.

We are within two hours' drive from Edinburgh, Glasgow, Aberdeen or Inverness via the main A9 road. There are train stations in Blair Atholl (½ a mile away) and Pitlochry (7 miles away), with regular connecting services from all major Scottish cities. A daily express service to and from London's Kings Cross station stops at Pitlochry, and the Caledonian Sleeper to and from London Euston stops at Blair Atholl station.

Imagine a holiday where you can relax in comfort in a tranquil woodland setting surrounded by the magnificent mountain scenery of Highland Perthshire.

On Atholl Estates, imagination becomes reality when you take a break in one of our new 2 and 3 bedroom self-catering woodland lodges. Situated close to the amenities of Blair Castle Caravan Park but nestled in a quiet woodland area.

Blair Castle Woodland Lodges offer a wonderful opportunity for couples or families to explore the Atholl Estates countryside or just relax.

A 40-mile network of way-marked trails for walking and cycling is just metres away and elusive creatures like roe deer and red squirrel live on the doorstep.

The lodges are available on a weekly basis (Friday to Friday) year round, and also on a short break basis during off-peak times. Short breaks run for 4 nights midweek (Monday to Friday) and for 3 nights at weekends (Friday to Monday).

Blair Castle's five Woodland Lodges are named after the rivers on Atholl Estates – Errochty, Tummel, Garry, Fender and Tilt. All are beautifully designed and have a contemporary feel and an informal and naturally light atmosphere. Each has an en-suite master bedroom and a separate bathroom. Errochty, Fender and Tilt lodges can sleep 4 people, in a double and a twin bedroom, whilst Garry and Tummel lodges each have an additional twin bedroom to sleep 6 people each.

The self-catering kitchen is fully fitted with modern appliances to make your stay as convenient as possible.

Adjacent to the kitchen is an open plan dining area, and facing that is the living room, complete with comfortable chairs and entertainment by cable TV and DVD player. There is good mobile phone reception for most operators on the site, and broadband internet service is available at the Caravan Park Reception building.

In addition, each woodland lodge has a large terraced patio with furniture where guests can relax and enjoy meals alfresco, against a backdrop of stunning Highland scenery. Each holiday lodge has been designed and located to provide guests with privacy and good views into the woods and further to the surrounding hills.

Stretching across 145,000 acres, Atholl Estates is a spectacular natural environment teeming with native wildlife including roe deer, red squirrels, black grouse and golden eagles.

Walkers and cyclists need only go a few steps to find themselves on Atholl Estates 40-mile network of way-marked trails. There is a route to suit every need, from the gentle mile-long Red Squirrel Trail to the more demanding 10-mile Glen Tilt Trail. For hardy hill walkers, the estate's seven Munros (hills above 3000 feet in elevation) provide a welcome challenge.

Regardless of interests or weather, our guests are never short of things to do!

Entry to Blair Castle and gardens is free to our woodland lodges guests and opportunities to go exploring by pony or land rover safari are conveniently close by.

Keen fishermen can also arrange a day on one of our salmon rivers or hill lochs and children can take a vintage tractor tour during the summer months.

Other regional attractions include retail emporium The House of Bruar, the Highland Wildlife Park, the Highland Folk Museum, Landmark Forest Adventure Park, Edradour and Bells Blair Athol distilleries, the Strathspey steam railway, Queens View and the historic towns of Pitlochry, Aberfeldy and Dunkeld.
